Due to the circumstances of Iraq since mid year of 2014 by ISIS controlling on most of the governorates and destroying the infrastructure of these governorates in all sectors like (Health, Water and sanitation, Education, Electricity, Agriculture and Trade.... etc.) the military operations started to freeing these governorates so the Ministry of Planning formed a committee that responsible for preparing a document called (Document of the General Framework of the National Plan for Reconstruction and Damaged Governorates due to the Terrorist and Military Attacks).

In order to determine the requirements of the reconstruction depending on the statistical data so the secretariat of the council of ministries releases the decision (259) in 15/8/2017 commissioned by the Ministry of Planning / CSO to supervise on programs and projects of this survey for the seven damaged governorates (Nineveh, Kirkuk, Salah al- Deen, Diala, Baghdad, Al- Anbar and Babylon).

This survey involved all the sectors including the housing sector which estimated in the office by using the applications of GIS due to the difficulty of getting these data in field.

1.2 Survey objectives

This survey aims to provide a database about:

1. The electricity production stations in all damaged types due to the terrorism works and fighting ISIS by the estimated costs of the damaged assets before they damaged by 2014 prices and by the type of the damage in addition to the estimated values of the damaged furniture and equipment.
2. Health institutions in all types and the total values of the damages alike whether in the building, furniture or in technical or medical equipment.
3. The estimated values of water production stations in all types, sanitation water treatment stations and assets by type of damage and the total estimated cost of the damaged assets.
4. Education sector by all stages and by the estimated values of the damaged assets and the estimated cost of the damaged unit alike whether in the building, furniture or in the other.
5. The institutions and the governmental buildings, total cost also the value of the furniture and its equipment.
6. The estimated value of the agricultural assets, the estimated cost of the damaged building, the irrigation system and also the livestock and cattle owner.

7. The estimated value of the industrial assets and the estimated cost of the damaged building of the industrial sector alike whether in the building and stocks.
8. The estimated value of the transport assets which includes (roads, railways, bridges and garagesetc.) and the estimated cost of the damages.
9. The estimated values of the water resources assets which includes (dams and stocks, stream and systemsetc.) and the estimated cost of the damages.
10. The estimated values of the oil assets and the estimated cost of the damages which includes the building, furniture, mechanisms, technical equipment.
11. The estimated values of the communication assets and the estimated cost of the damages.
12. The estimated values of the environment assets and the estimated cost of the damages.
13. The estimated values of the culture assets and the estimated cost of the damages.
14. The estimated values of the trade assets and the estimated cost of the damages.
15. Providing spatial database for the damages of the residential buildings that belong to the private sector due to the terrorism works, the database is about:
(A): The spatial data of the damaged residential buildings sites in the involved governorates.
(B): Data about the number of the damaged residential buildings in each governorate.
(C): Data about the area of the damaged residential buildings in each governorate.
(D): The estimated value of the housing sector damages in each governorate by the environment (urban and rural).

1.3 Results and expected benefits of the survey

1. Providing data about the full and part damaged economical assets by sector and governorate.
2. Providing data about the total value of the full and part damaged economical assets by 2014 prices by sector and governorate.
3. Providing data about the full and part damaged building by sector and governorate.
4. Providing data about the furniture and stocks.
5. Providing data about the damaged mechanisms and vehicles.
6. Providing data about the damaged value of the equipment and mechanisms.
7. Providing data about the number of the totally or partially damaged residential buildings.
8. Providing data about the area of the damaged residential buildings.
9. Providing data about the number of the cities and villages that the housing sector damaged in.
10. Providing data about the estimated values of the totally and partially damaged residential building.

2. Work Methodology

2.1 .Forming Committees: There are five committees formed from the relevant ministries, ministry of planning and CSO which are (operation, high committee, technical committee, administrative and financial committee and IT committee).

2.2 . A work team for the residential building damages (technical team, damages listing team, editing team and IT team) formed from the ministry of planning and CSO- GIS Center in order to get the data about the damages in the residential buildings.

2.3 .Designing questionnaire: For the purpose of implementing and conducting this survey, many meetings were held for designing sectorial questionnaires through forming sectorial teamwork from the ministry of planning and representative from high and technical committees from the sectorial ministries.

The questionnaires involved the following sectors:

2.4 .Satellite images: A high resolution satellite images were depended for the comparison between the damages of the housing sector during (2014, 2015, 2017) by the (world view 3-world, world view 1- view 2) these images were provided by the (UN- HABITAT) which is one of the international support for this survey.

2.5 .Spatial data: In the GIS Center there is a spatial database for the residential buildings in Iraq for 2010 and updated through the satellite images for 2014 for the involved governorates in this survey.

2.6 .Output tables (The Infrastructure and Governmental Buildings Damages) : The output tables are designed to cover the most important indicators at sector and governorate level.

2.7 .Output tables (The Residential Buildings Damages): The output tables are designed to cover the most important indicators at governorate and environment level (urban and rural).

2.8 Checking instructions and rules:(The Infrastructure and Governmental Buildings Damages): The instructions of filling the questionnaire and data checking were prepared.

2.9.Checking rules (The Residential Buildings Damages):Checking team in GIS Center conducting the data checking rules.

2.10. Level of representation: This survey covered all the sectors damaged by the terrorism works and fighting ISIS in the involved governorates (Nineveh, Kirkuk, Salah Al- Deen, Diala, Baghdad, Al- Anbar and Babylon). Also it covered the residential buildings for the private sector in the damaged governorates and in urban and rural areas.

2.11. Timeframe (The Infrastructure and Governmental Buildings Damages): A detailed table of timeframe for all stages of this survey was prepared in order to make a clear methodology, this survey started in (24/9/2017) till (29/11/2017) in the involved governorates.

2.15.Office work (the Infrastructure and Governmental Buildings Damages): After finishing the fieldwork and receiving the forms from the sectorial ministries the edit team had formed in the CSO, and the forms edited there and when there is any note or enquiry the editor make a call with the statistic and planning department in the governorate in order to get the correct data.

2.16.Office work (The Residential Buildings Damages):The GIS Center in the CSO has conducting the office work with the UN-HABITAT.

2.17.Programs (The Residential Buildings Damages):The following programs are used in this survey for comparison, analysis, listing, calculating results and producing tables and maps purposes.

2.18.Fieldwork(The Residential Buildings Damages):The statistics department in the governorates provided the data about the buildings in the rural areas (rural villages) also a field data about the urban areas in order to assess the office

2.19 Data entry and preparing the results (The Infrastructure and Governmental Buildings Damages): Due to the high number of the sectorial forms so many entry programs prepared by using (CSPro) and (Excel) programs for entry data and output the result by using (SPSS).

2.20.Work implementation for urban cities (The Residential Buildings Damages):

- ✚ Inserting the spatial data of the residential buildings for (2009,2010) on the satellite images for 2010.
- ✚ Make a comparison between the satellite images for (2010, 2015) to update the residential buildings.
- ✚ Make a comparison between the satellite images for (2010, 2015, and 2017) to update the damaged residential buildings.
- ✚ Classifying the damaged residential buildings.
- ✚ Identifying the number of the damaged residential buildings by using the Arc GIS program.

- ✿ Calculating the building areas for each damaged building taking into consideration the number of the floors for each building according to the following formula:

The building area= the building area by the satellite images × the number of floors

- ✿ Estimating the damages of the residential buildings according to the following formula:
(The building area× the building price× the percentage of the partial damage 40%).

2.21 Work implementation for rural cities (The Residential Buildings Damages):

- ✿ The statistics departments in the governorates provide us with the names of the damaged villages and the damage percentage for each village.
- ✿ The damaged village will determine on the satellite images for 2010 through the spatial data of the village for 2010.
- ✿ The area and the number of the damaged buildings calculated through the satellite images for 2010.
- ✿ The damaged residential buildings determined through the Arc GIS program.
- ✿ The area of each damaged building calculated through the following formula:

The area of the building= the area of the building by the satellite images × the number of floors

One floor for the residential buildings is depended in the rural villages.

The estimated cost of the damaged unit:

It means the estimated value of the damaged unit due to the terrorism works and fighting ISIS after 2014.

The residential building: it means a place where the human being lives with his necessary needs. This building consists of one room or more with one floor or more.

The area of the building: it means an architectural concept and consists of areas of ceiled building and it calculated by multiplying the building area with the number of floors.

The building cost price: it means the price of the meter in the building in Iraqi dinar, where the price in (2015, 2016, 2017) is between (250000- 500000) ID.

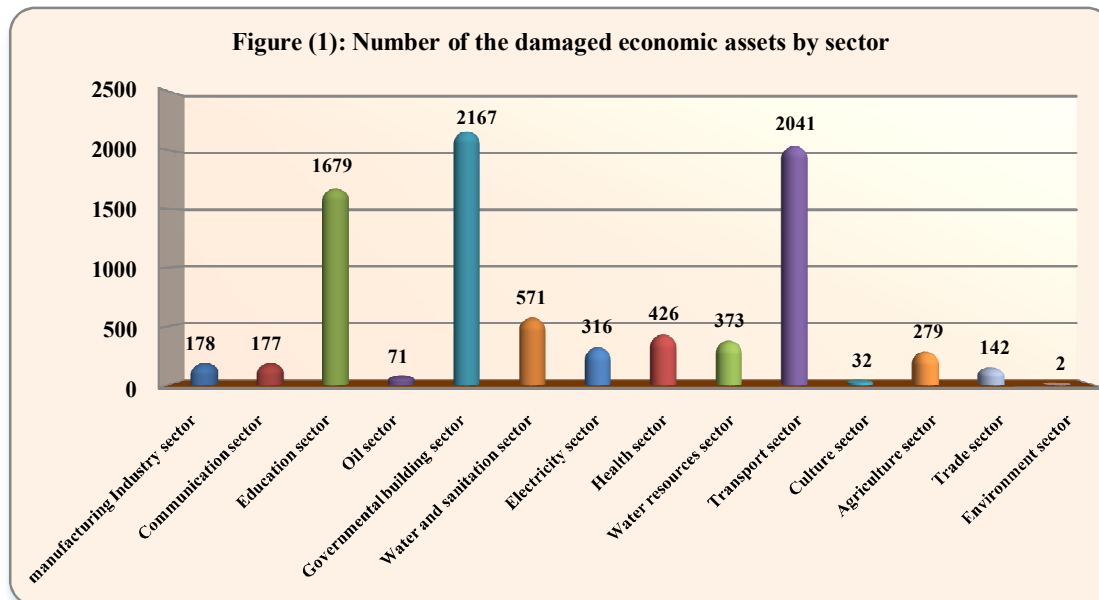
The urban region: it means the region within the municipalities or Baghdad mayoralty borders.

The rural region: it means the region outside the municipalities or Baghdad mayoralty borders.

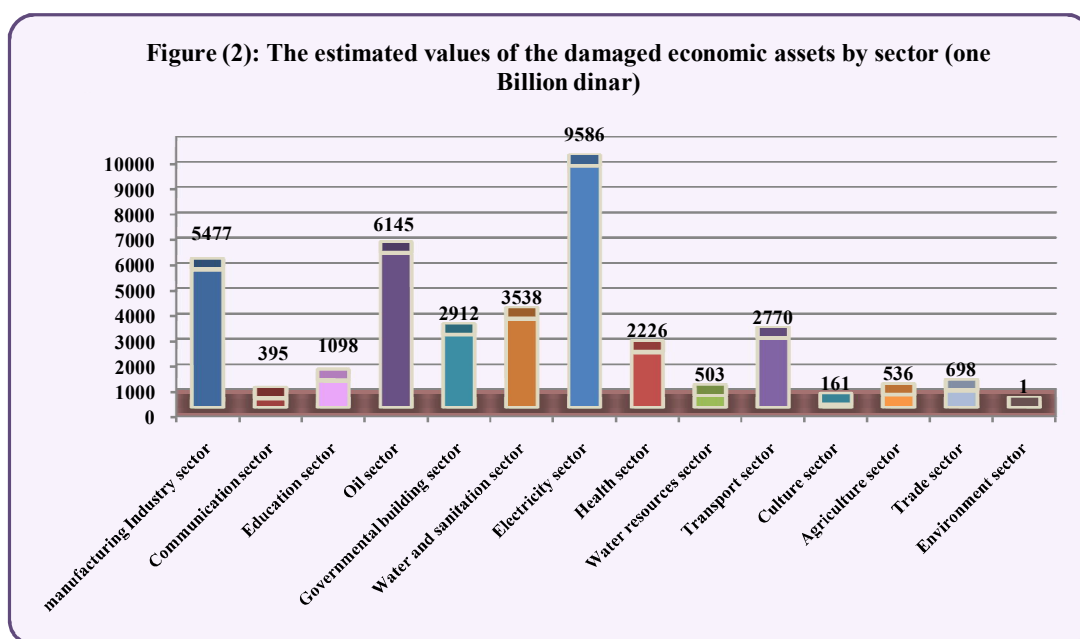
The estimated value of the damaged unit: it means multiplying the area of the damaged residential buildings by the average price of building for one meter by type of damage.

4. Results of the Survey

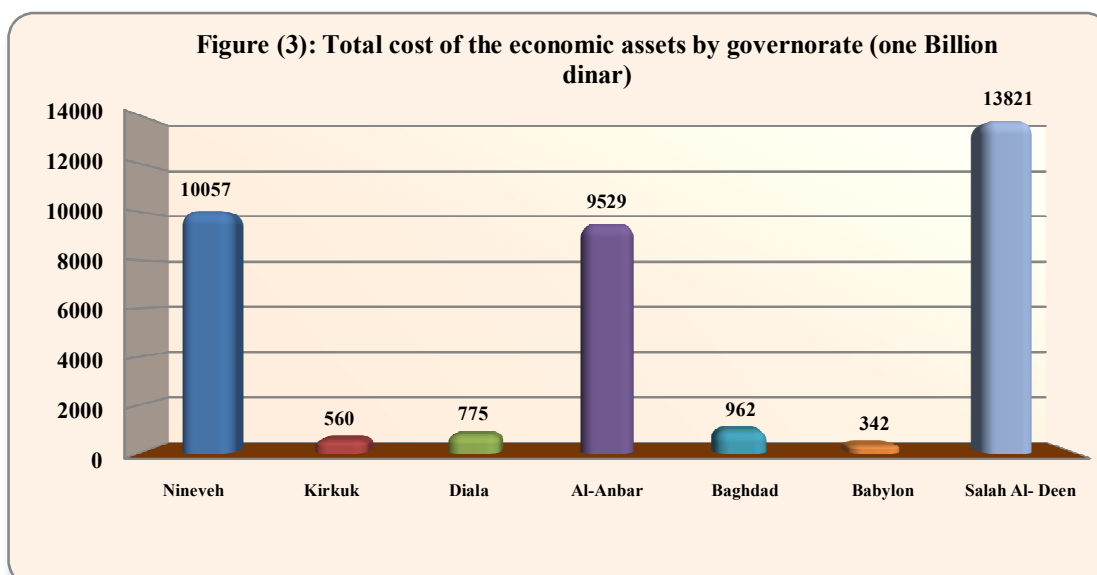
- ✚ This section contains the most important results from the data of the ministries and the governorates noting that some of the ministries had no enough data.
- ✚ The number of the damaged economic assets reached (8457) assets the biggest number was in the governmental building sector as (2167) assets then transport sector as (2041) assets as in table (1) and figure (1).



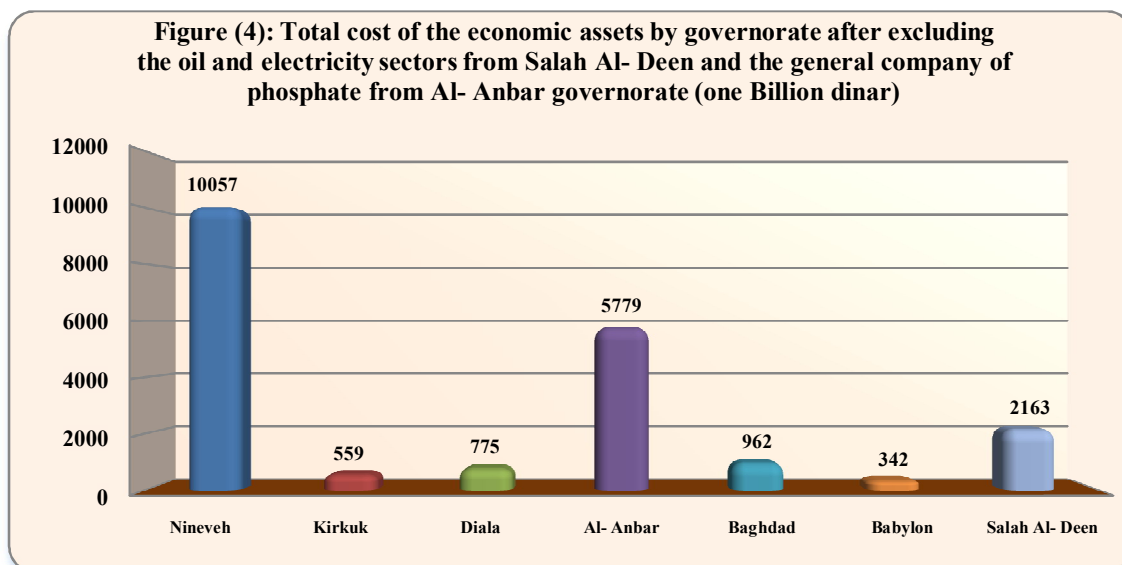
- ✚ Also the results showed that the number of the totally damaged economic assets (40% and more) reached (6475) assets while the number of the partially damaged economic assets (less than 40%) reached (1982) assets.
- ✚ The result of the survey showed that the total cost of the damaged economic assets by 2014 prices reached (75.306) trillion dinar for most of the sectors.
- ✚ The results showed that the most damaged sector is the electricity sector and by (9.586) trillion dinar then oil and gas sector as (6.145) trillion dinar then the manufacturing industry sector as (5.477) trillion dinar because it is one of the biggest sectors by share capital in serving most of the governorates, the total cost of the damaged assets in the ministries reached (20.514) trillion dinar and in the residential buildings sector reached (18.746) trillion dinar as shown in figure (2).



✚ The results of the survey in table (3) shows that the damaged economic assets in Salah Al- Deen were the highest among the involved governorates as (13.821) trillion dinar then Nineveh as (10.057) trillion dinar then Al- Anbar as (9.529) trillion dinar the reason for this increasing is due to the refineries existing and electricity stations in this governorate where the value of the damages in Salah Al- Deen in electricity sector (5.879) trillion dinar and in oil and gas sector reached (5.779) trillion dinar as shown in figure (3).



✚ And in case we excluded these damages so Salah Al- Deen will be at the third stage after Nineveh and Al- Anbar.



✚ The results in table (3) also shows that water and sanitation sector is the most damaged sector in Ninevah as (2.723) trillion dinar and the lowest damage was in agriculture sector as (30) one million dinar, while in Kirkuk governorate the water and sanitation sector was the most damaged sector as (157) one million dinar and the lowest damaged sector was in oil and gas sector as (138) million dinar.

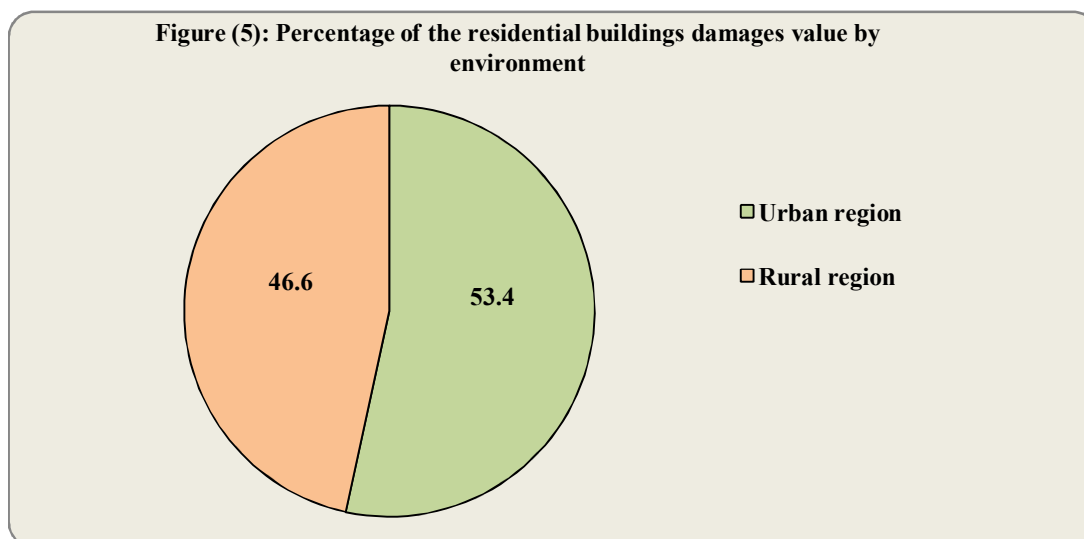
✚ In the same table the results showed that the industry sector in Al- Anbar governorate is the most damaged sector as (4.579) trillion dinar due to the existing of the general company of phosphate which is one of the huge damaged companies as (3.750) trillion dinar which is the reason in rising the value of the damage in the industry sector in the governorate while the lowest damaged sector in the governorate was in the environment sector as (840) million dinar.

✚ While in Baghdad governorate the electricity sector was the most damaged sector as (367) one million dinar then the water and sanitation as (181) one million dinar.

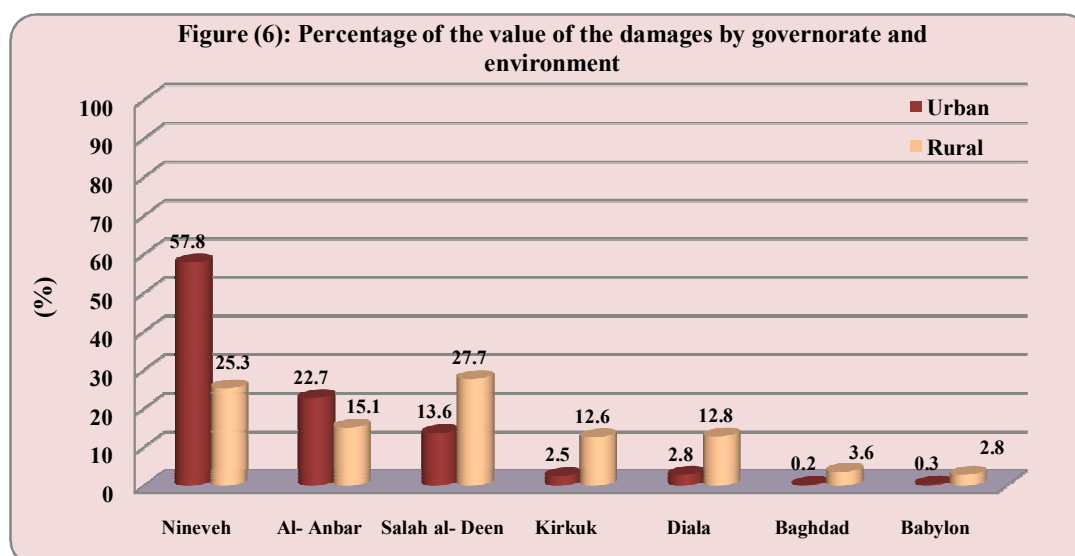
✚ In spite of considering Babylon as the lowest damaged governorate where the total damage was (342) one million dinar and the electricity sector was the most damaged sector as (146)one million dinar then water and sanitation as (52) one million dinar.

✚ While in Salah Al- Deen governorate the electricity sector was the most damaged sector as (5.879) trillion dinar then oil and gas sector as (5.779) trillion dinar then the governmental buildings sector as (789) one million dinar, while the lowest damaged sector was the culture sector as (290) million dinar.

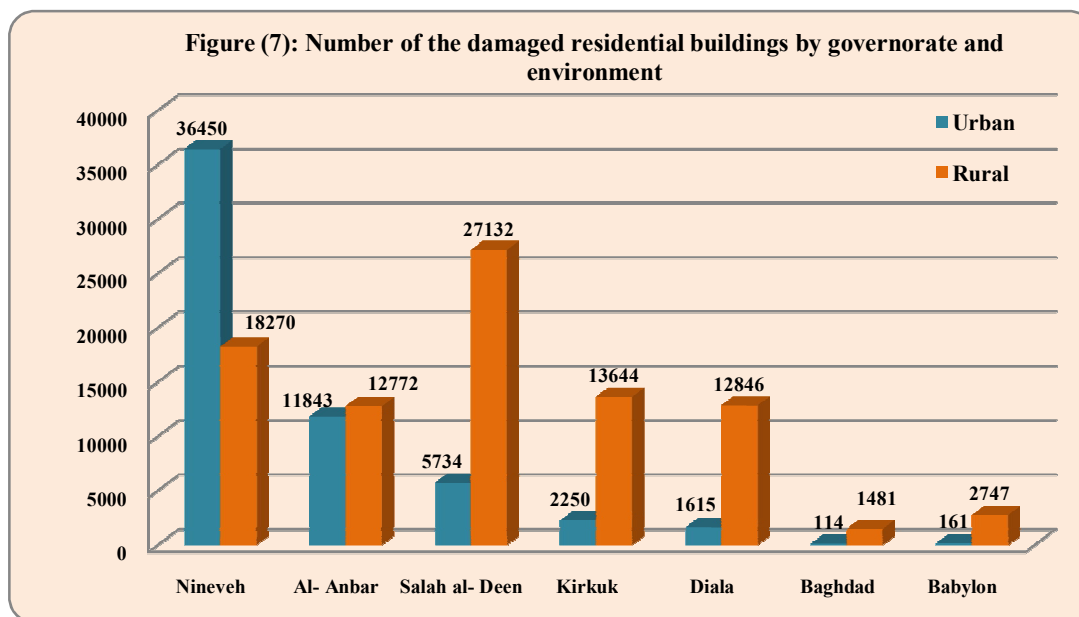
- ✚ The results in table (21) showed that the estimated value of the total damaged residential buildings for the private sector in the involved governorates was (18.7) trillion dinar where the estimated value in the urban region was (10) trillion dinar and as (53.4%), while in the rural region was (8.7) trillion dinar and as (46.6%) as shown in figure (5).



- ✚ Also these results showed that the residential buildings in Nineveh were damaged more than the other governorates (8) trillion dinar and as (42.7%) then Salah al- Deen (3.8) trillion dinars and as (20.2%) then Al- Anbar (3.6) trillion dinars as (19.2%).
- ✚ This table also shows that the highest value of the damaged residential buildings in the urban region was in Nineveh (5.8) trillion dinars as (57.8%) then Al- Anbar (2.3) trillion dinar as (22.7%) then Salah al- Deen (1.4) trillion dinars as (13.6%) and as shown in figure (6).



- ✚ Also the results showed that the highest value of the damaged residential buildings in the rural villages was in Salah al- Deen (2.4) trillion dinars as (27.7%) then Nineveh (2.2) trillion dinar as (25.3%) then Al- Anbar (1.3) trillion dinars as (15.1%).
- ✚ The results in tables (22, 23) showed that the number of the damaged buildings in the rural region is higher than in the urban region (88892, 58167) respectively and as (60.4%, 39.6%).
- ✚ In the same tables the result showed that the residential buildings in the urban of Nineveh were the highest number (36450) buildings and as (62.7%) then Al- Anbar (11843) buildings as (20.4%). While the number of the residential buildings in the rural of Salah al- Deen were the highest (27132) and as (30.5%) then Nineveh (18270) and as (20.6%) as shown in figure (7).



Also these results showed that the total area of the damaged buildings reached (73.4) million m² distributed on the seventh governorates and the highest percentage was in the urban region as (56.2%).

The areas of the damaged buildings in Nineveh formed the highest percentage (45.3%) and as (33.3) million m² then Salah Al- Deen (18.9%) as (13.9) million m².

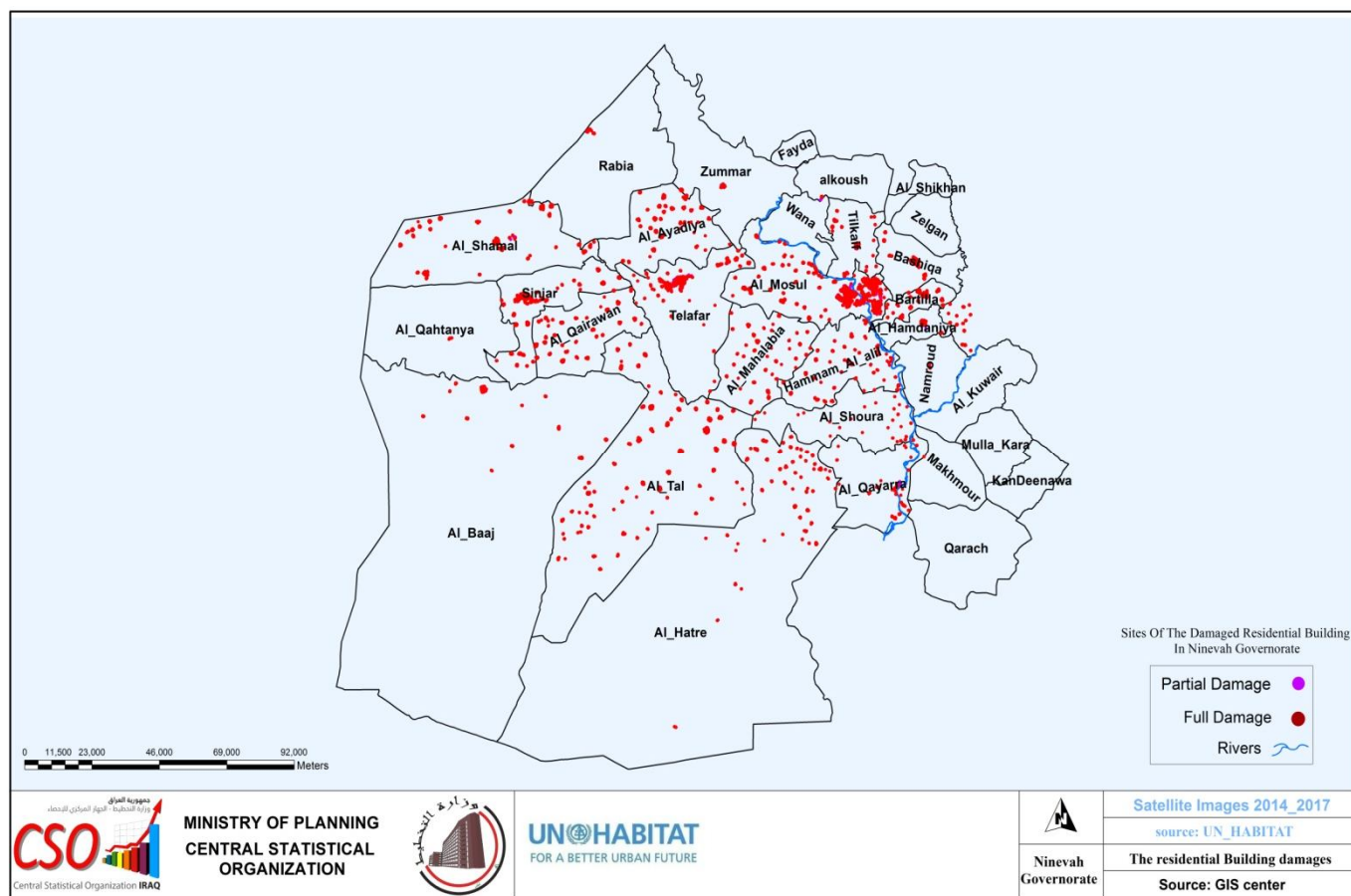

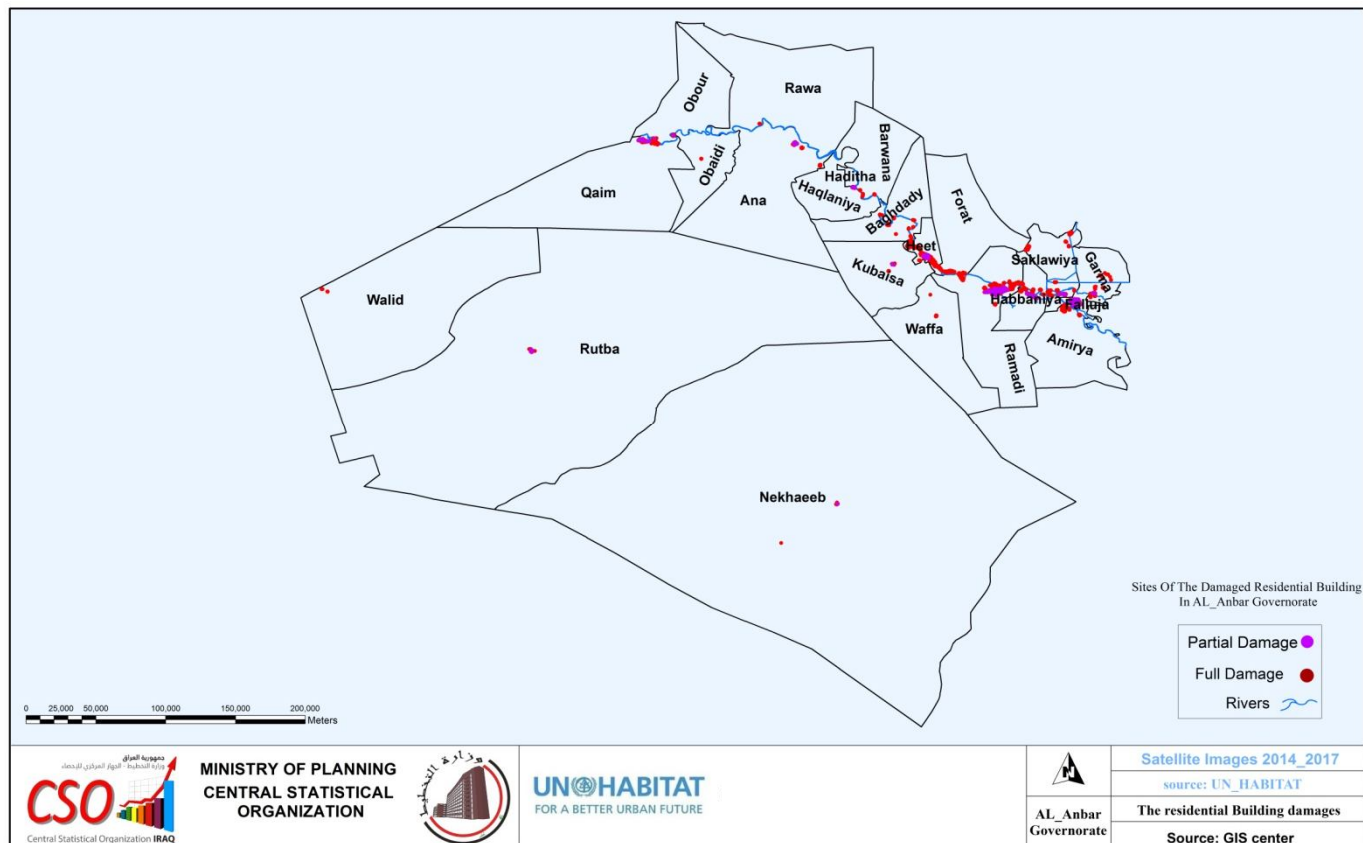

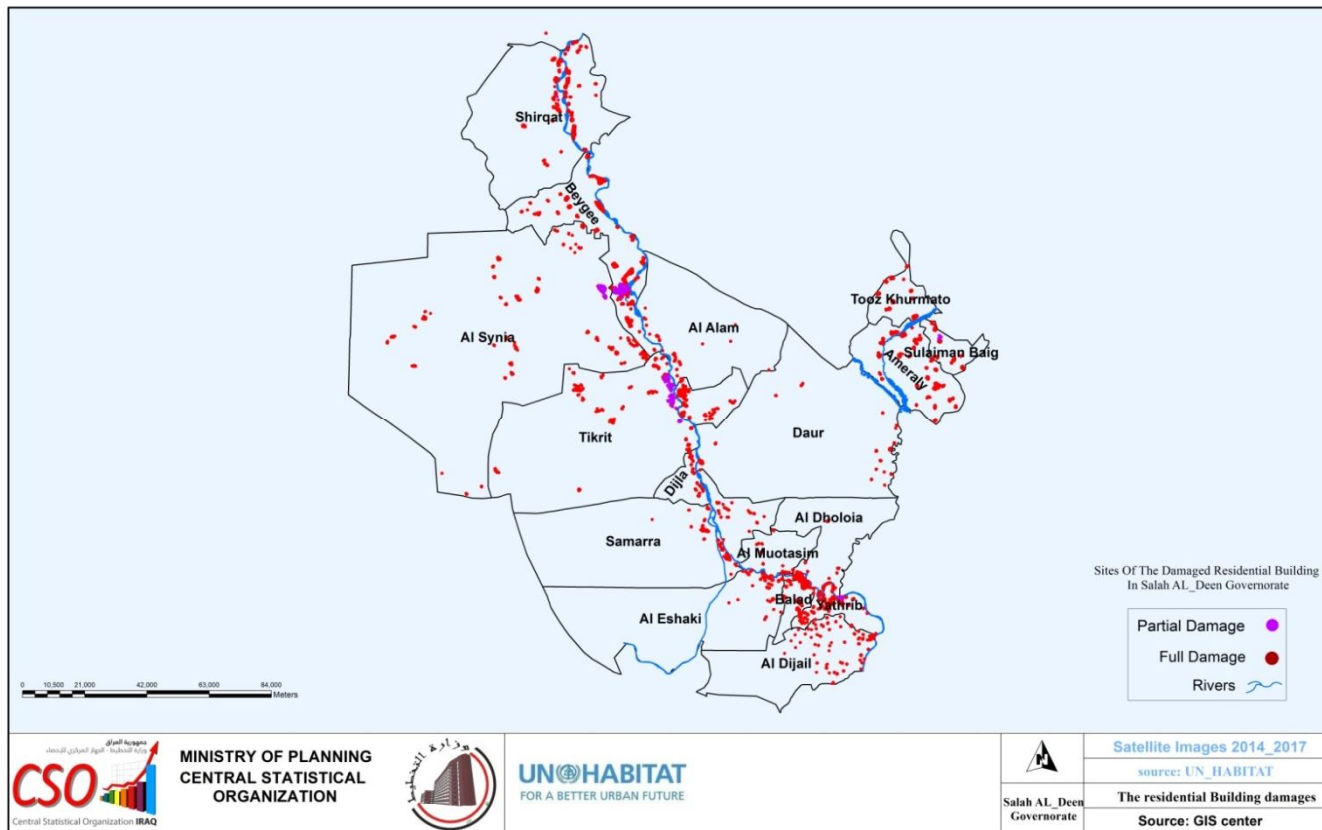
Map 1 : Sites of the damaged residential buildings in Nineveh governorate



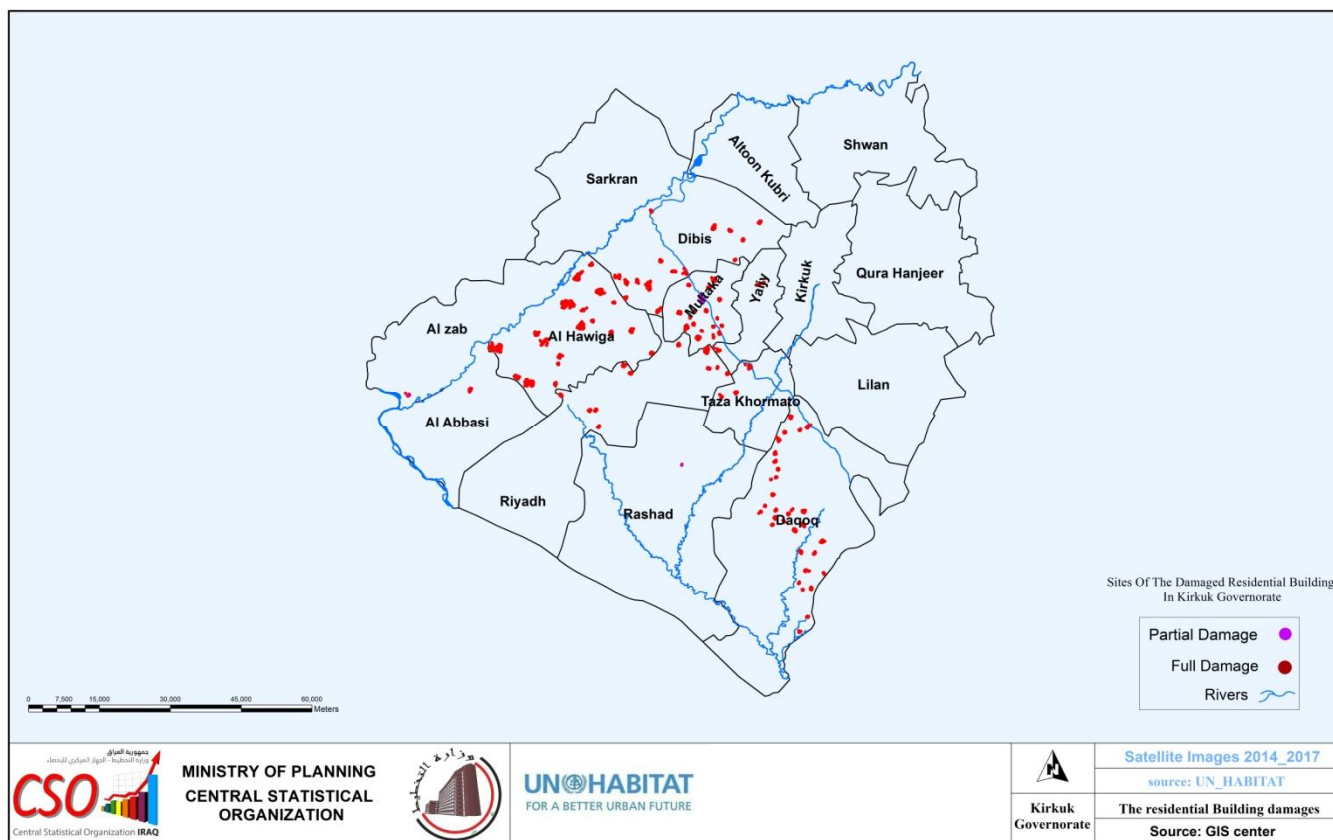
Map 2 : Sites of the damaged residential buildings in Al- Anbar governorate



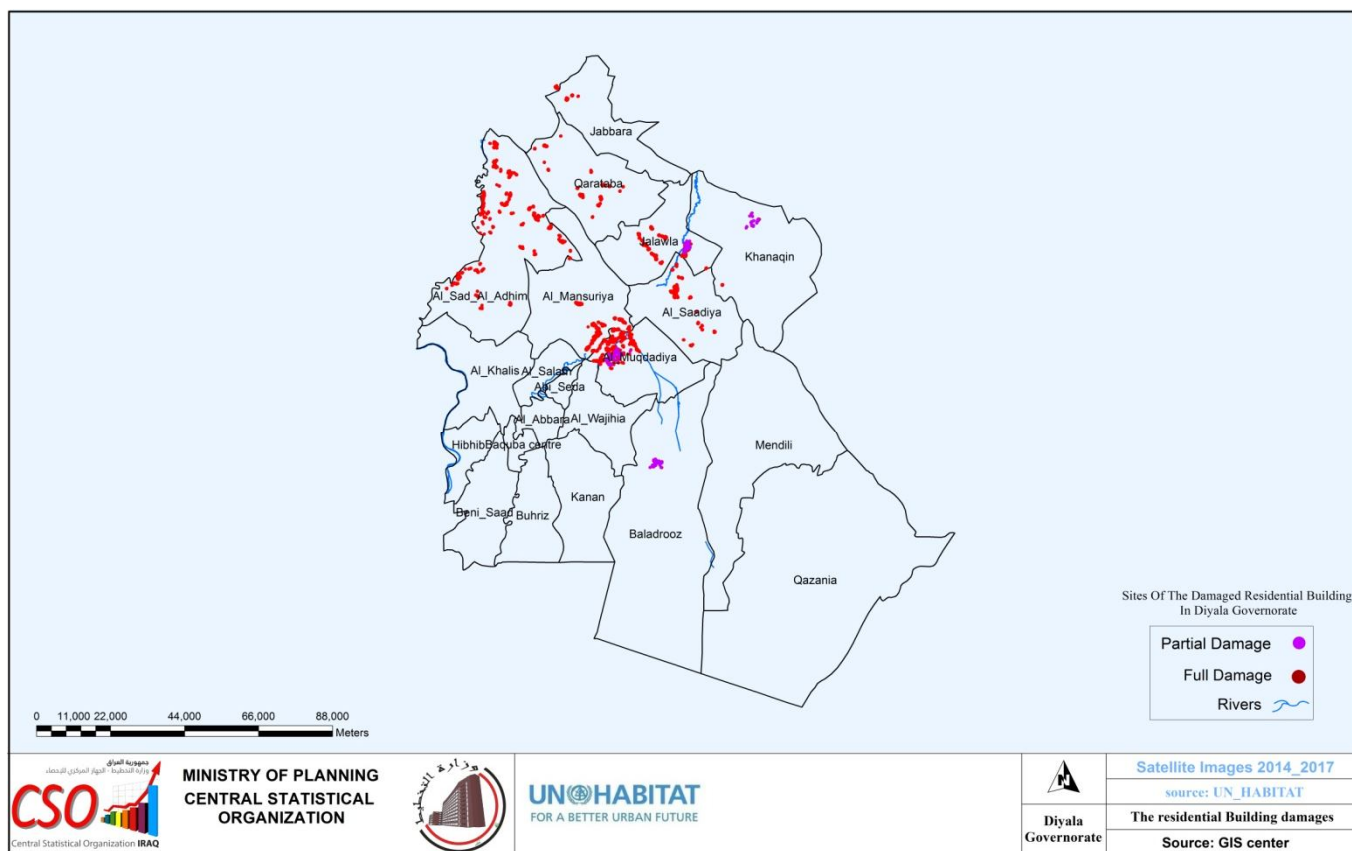
Map 3 : Sites of the damaged residential buildings in Salah Al- Deen governorate



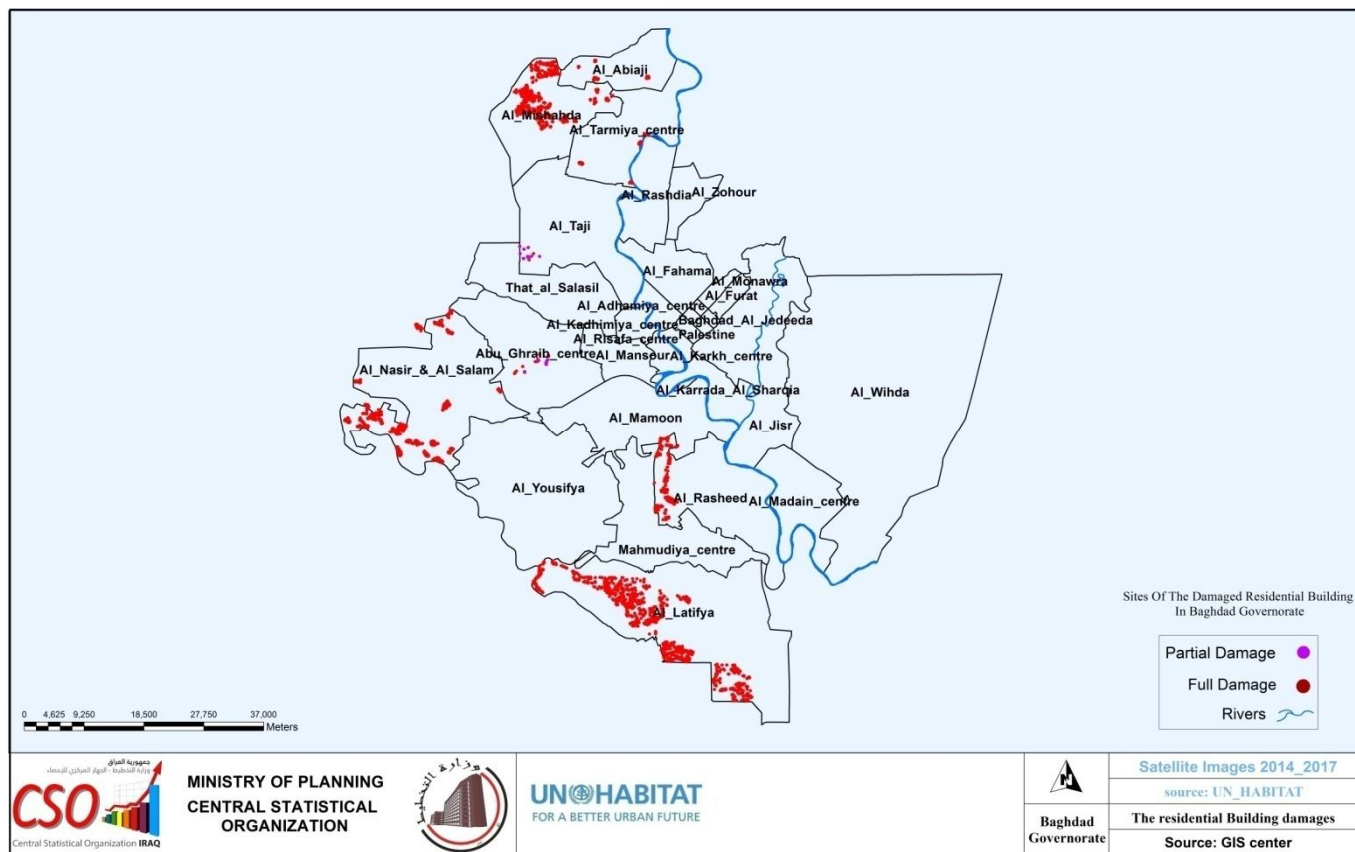
Map 4 : Sites of the damaged residential buildings in Kirkuk governorate



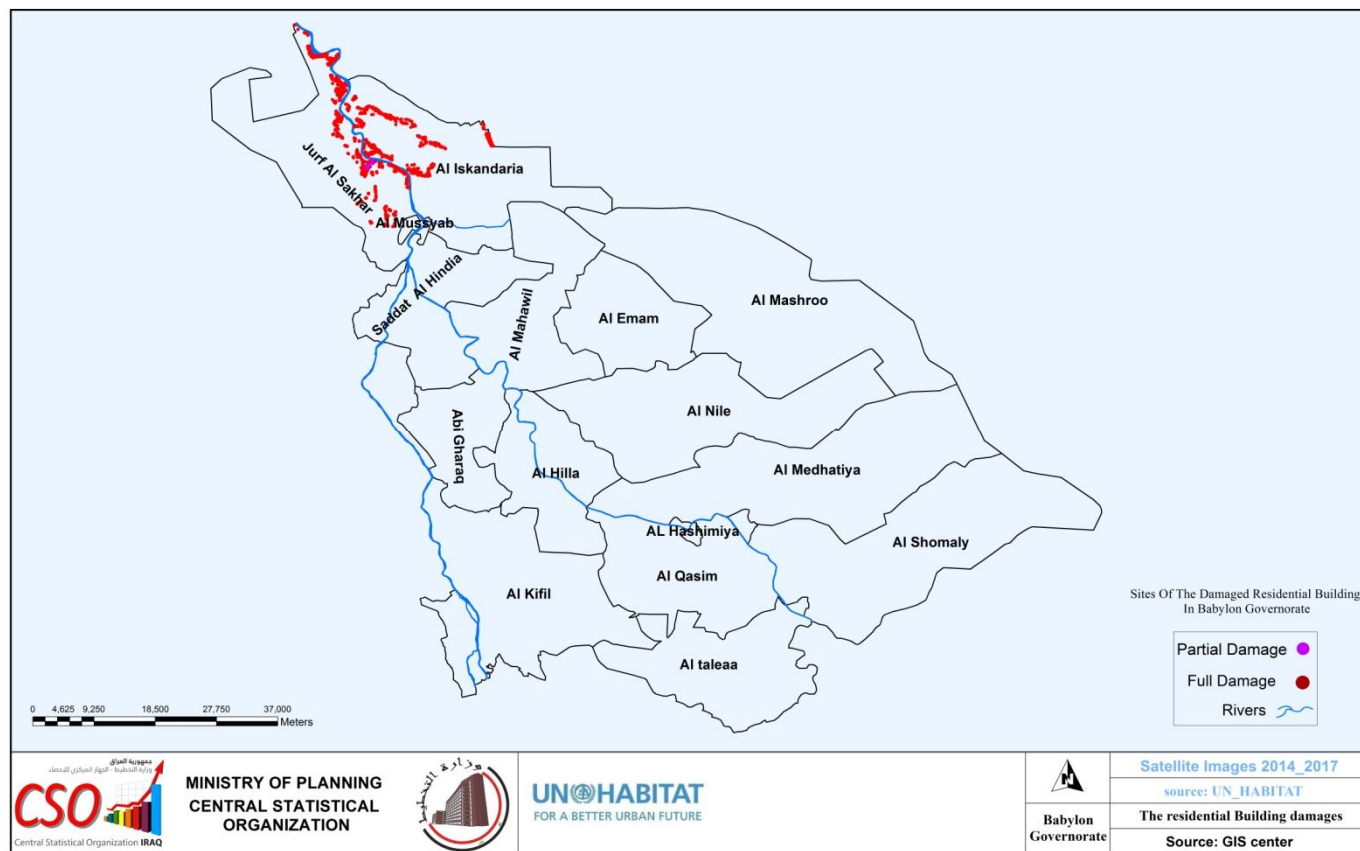
Map 5 : Sites of the damaged residential buildings in Diala governorate



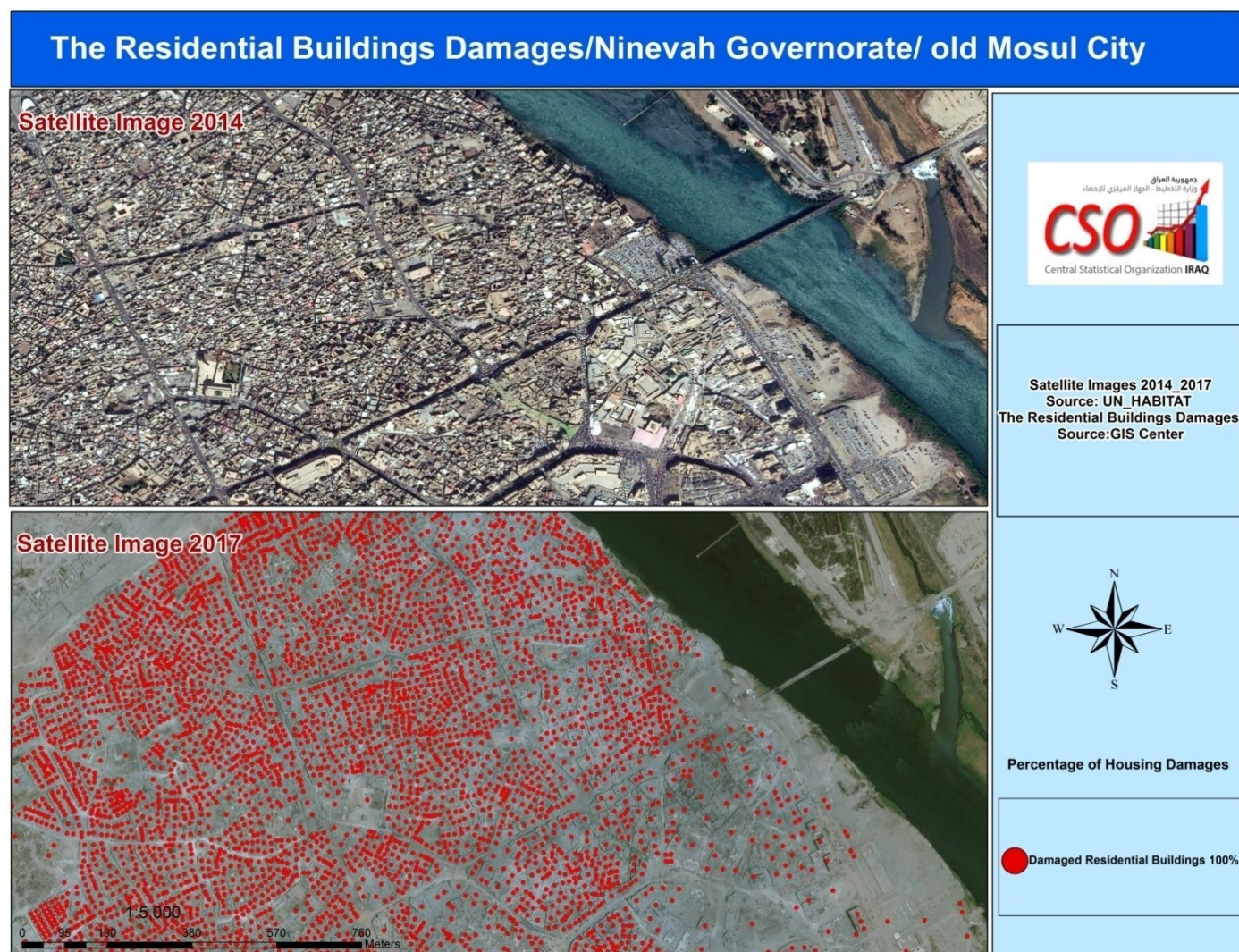
Map 6 : Sites of the damaged residential buildings in Baghdad governorate



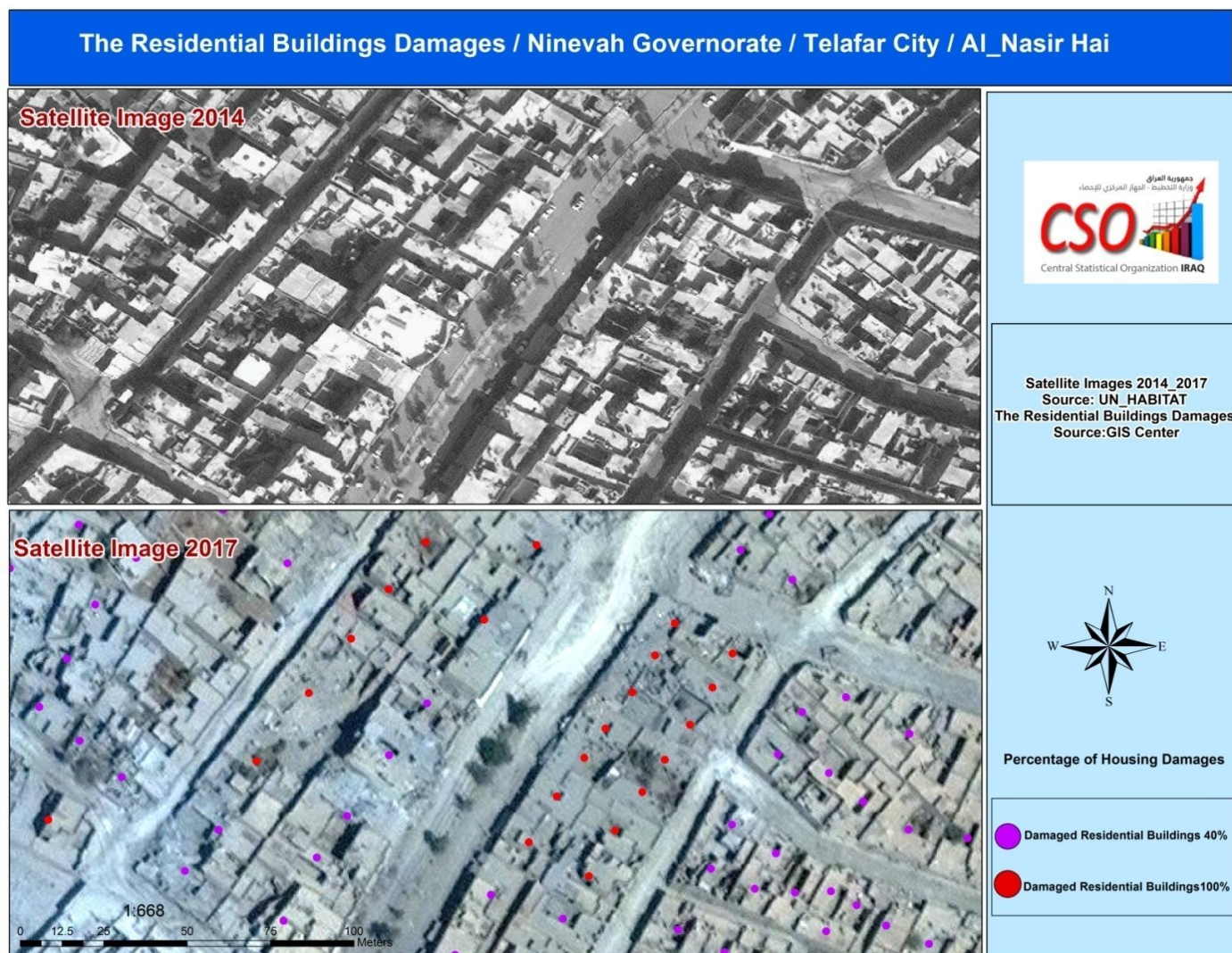
Map 7 : Sites of the damaged residential buildings in Babylon governorate



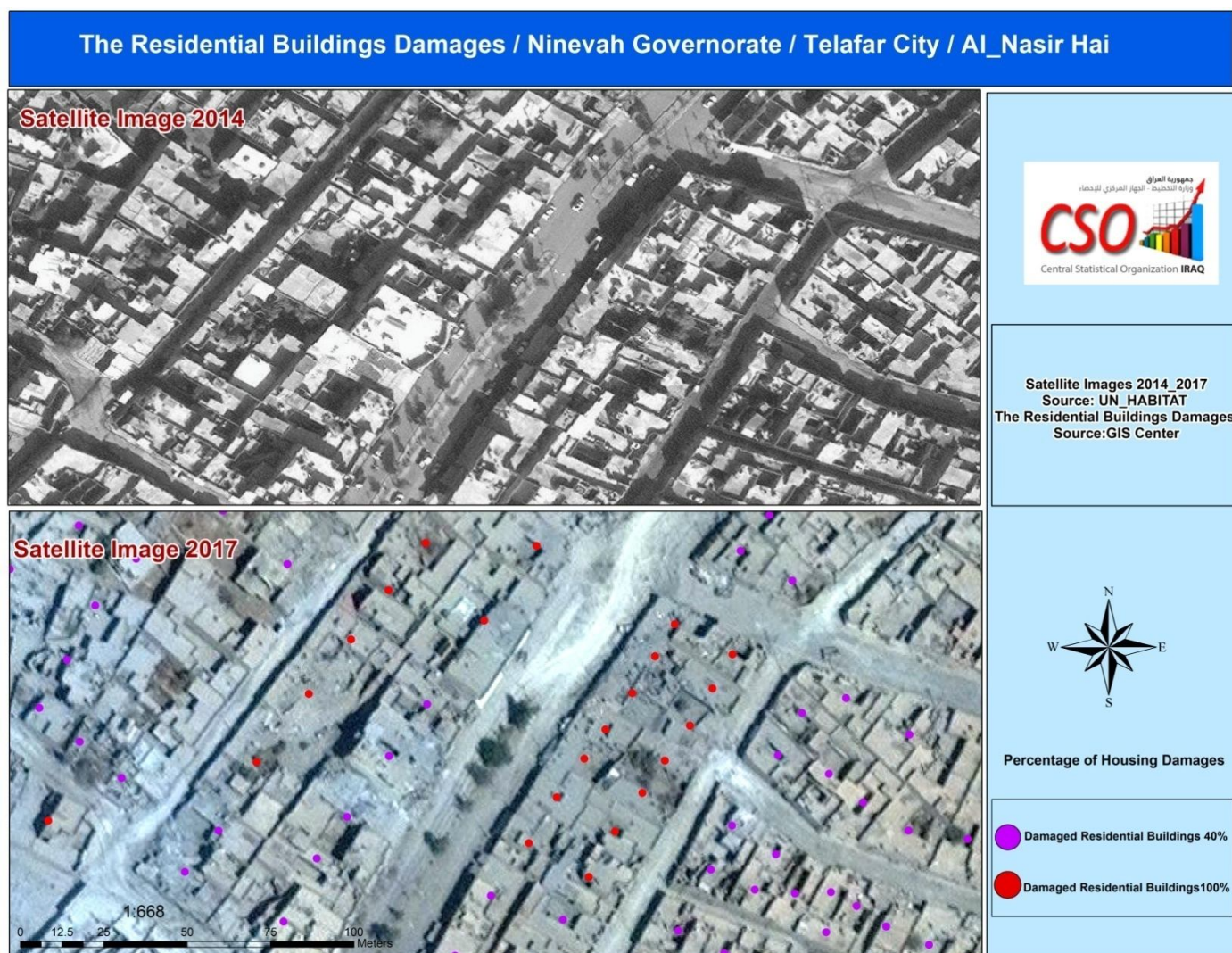
Map 8 : Comparison for the residential region in Al- Musel city for the years 2014 and 2017



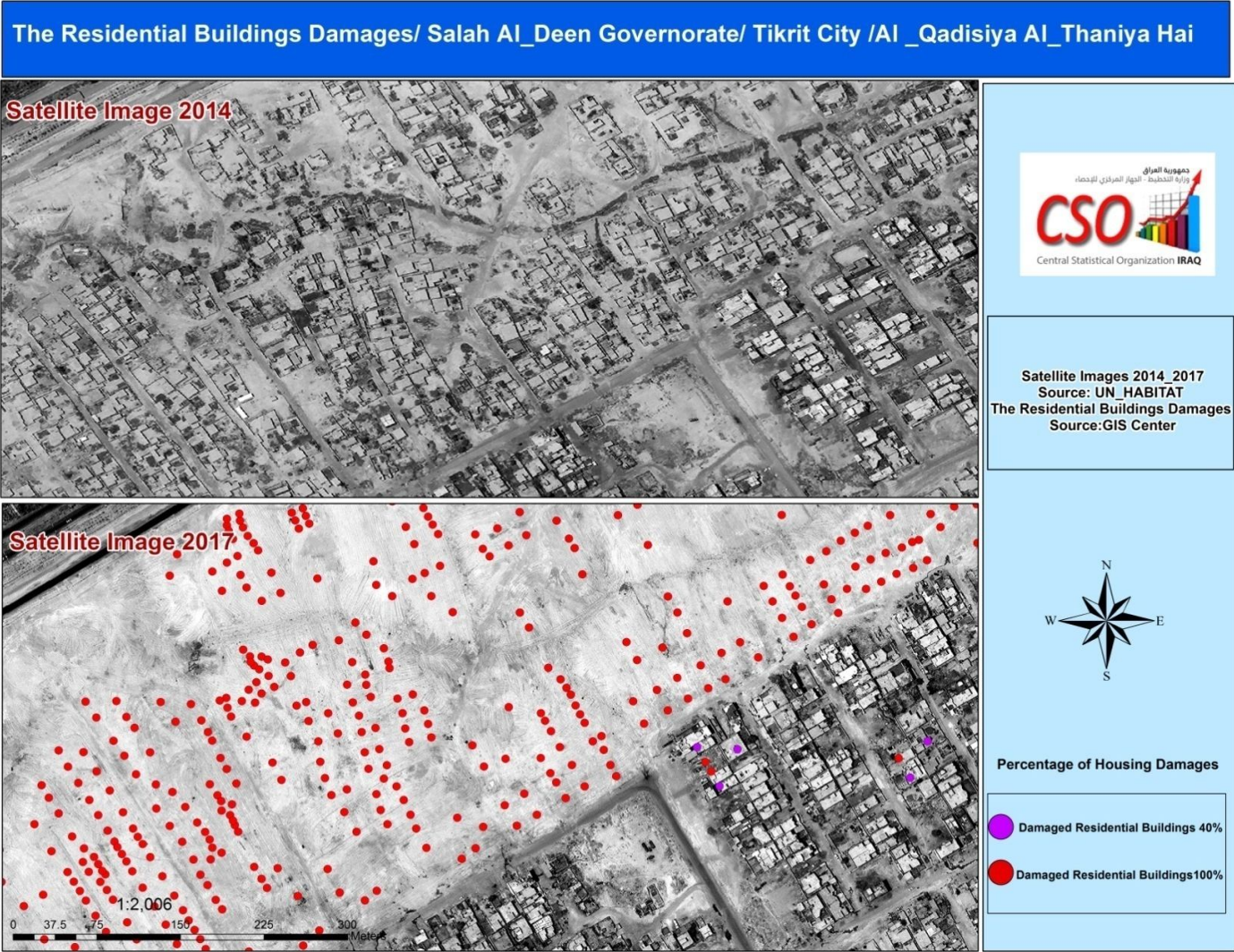
Map (9) : Comparison for the residential region in Sinjar city for the years 2014 and 2017



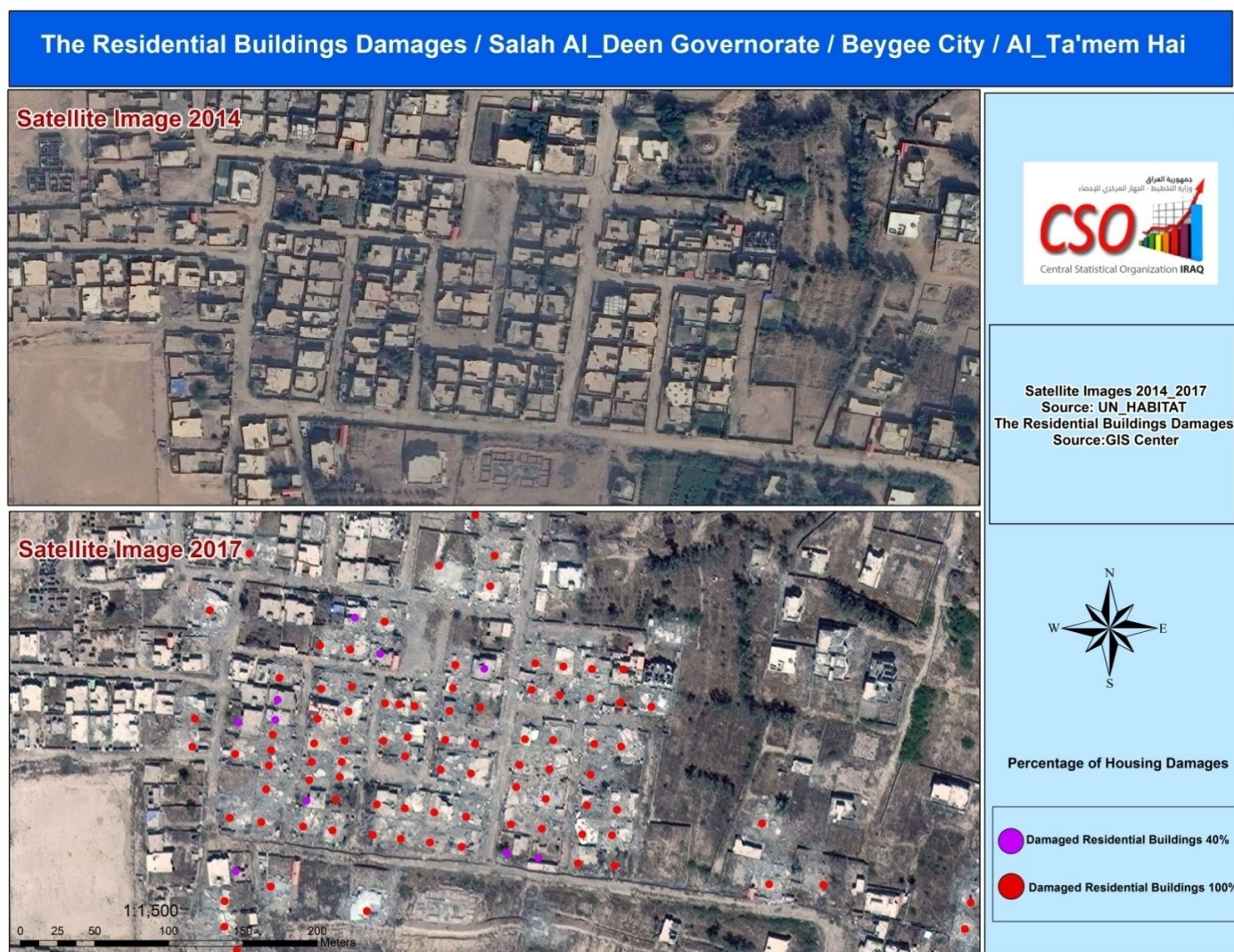
Map (10) : Comparison for the residential region in Tala'far city for the years 2014 and 2017



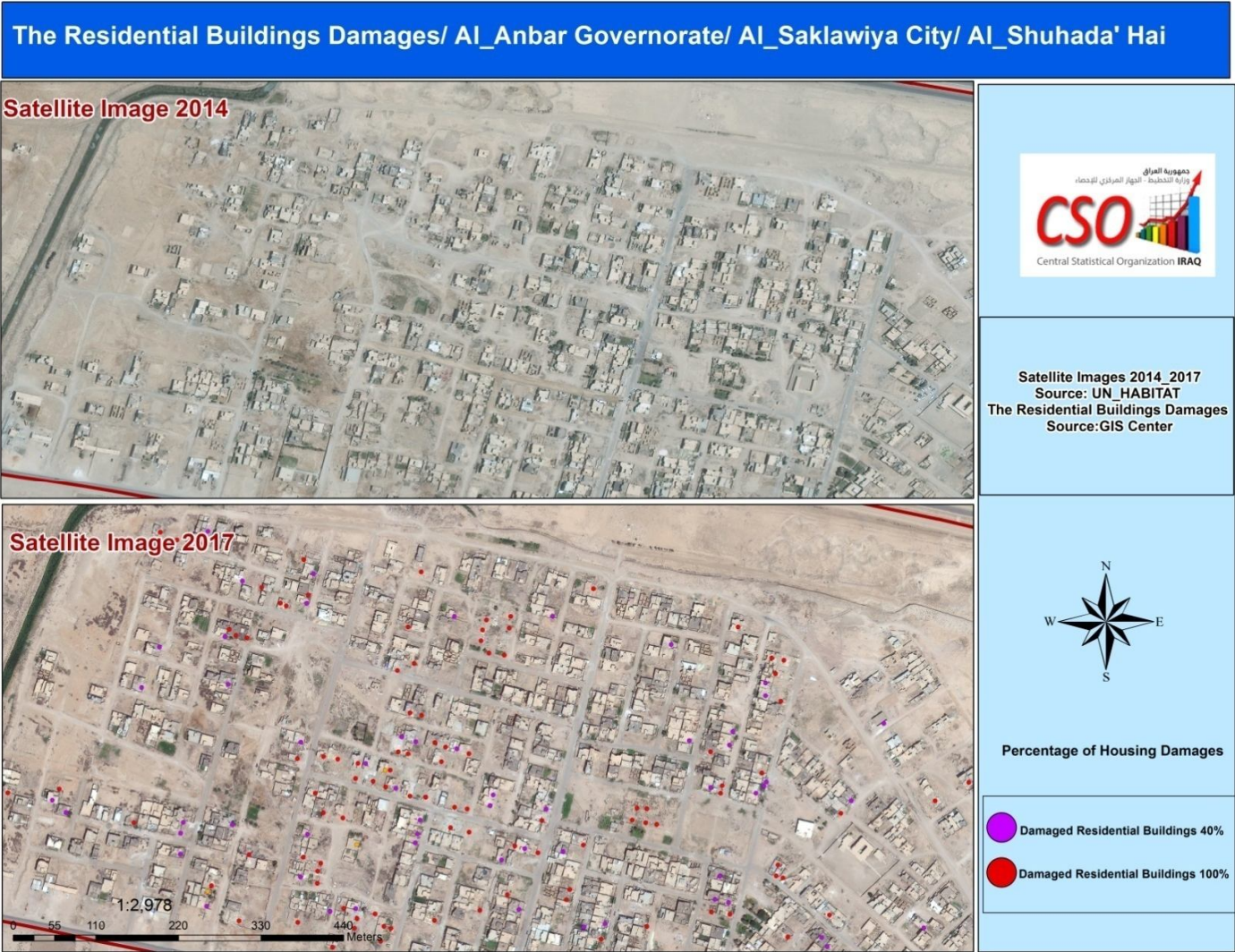
Map (11) : Comparison for the residential region in Tikreet city for the years 2014 and 2017



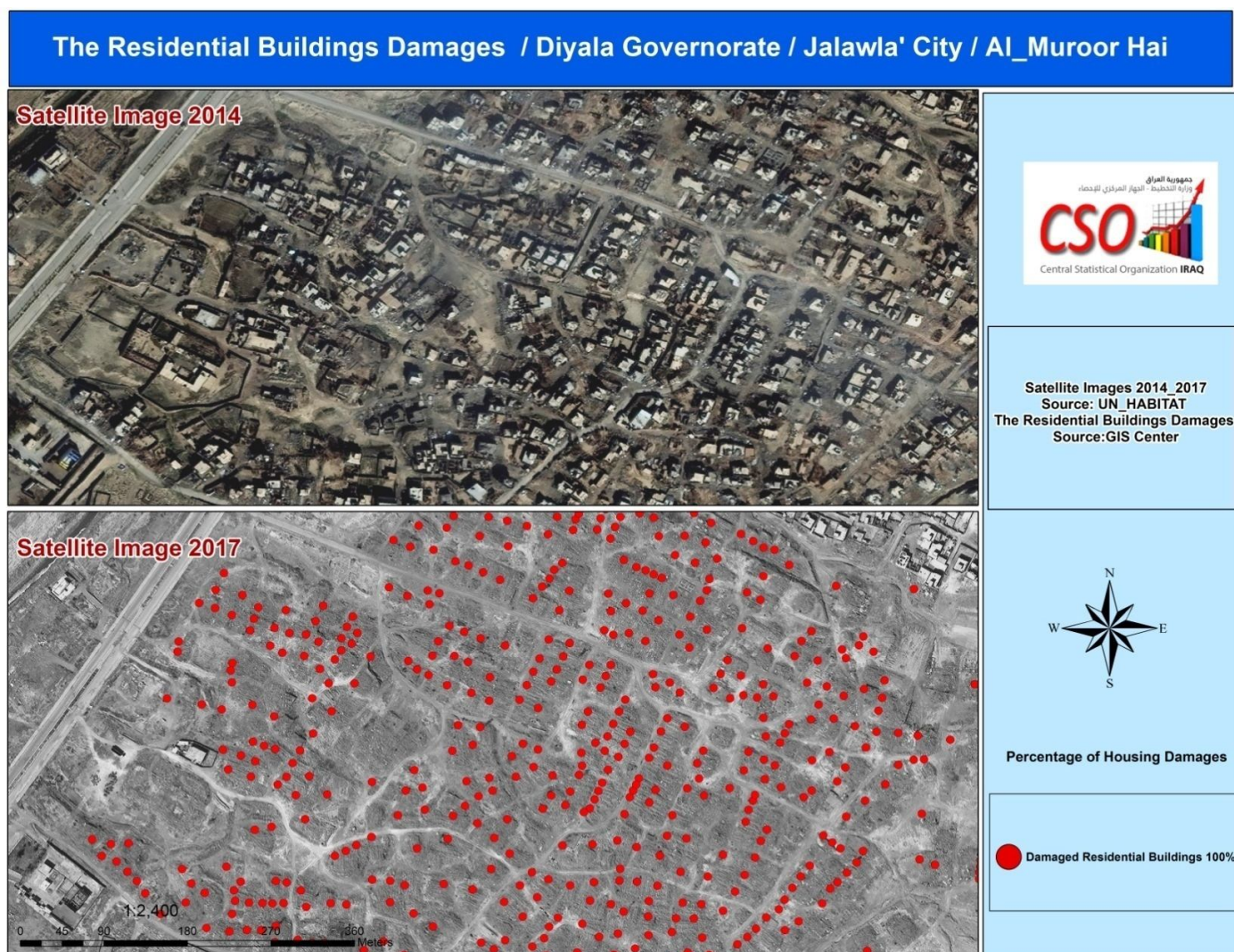
Map (12) : Comparison for the residential region in Beji city for the years 2014 and 2017



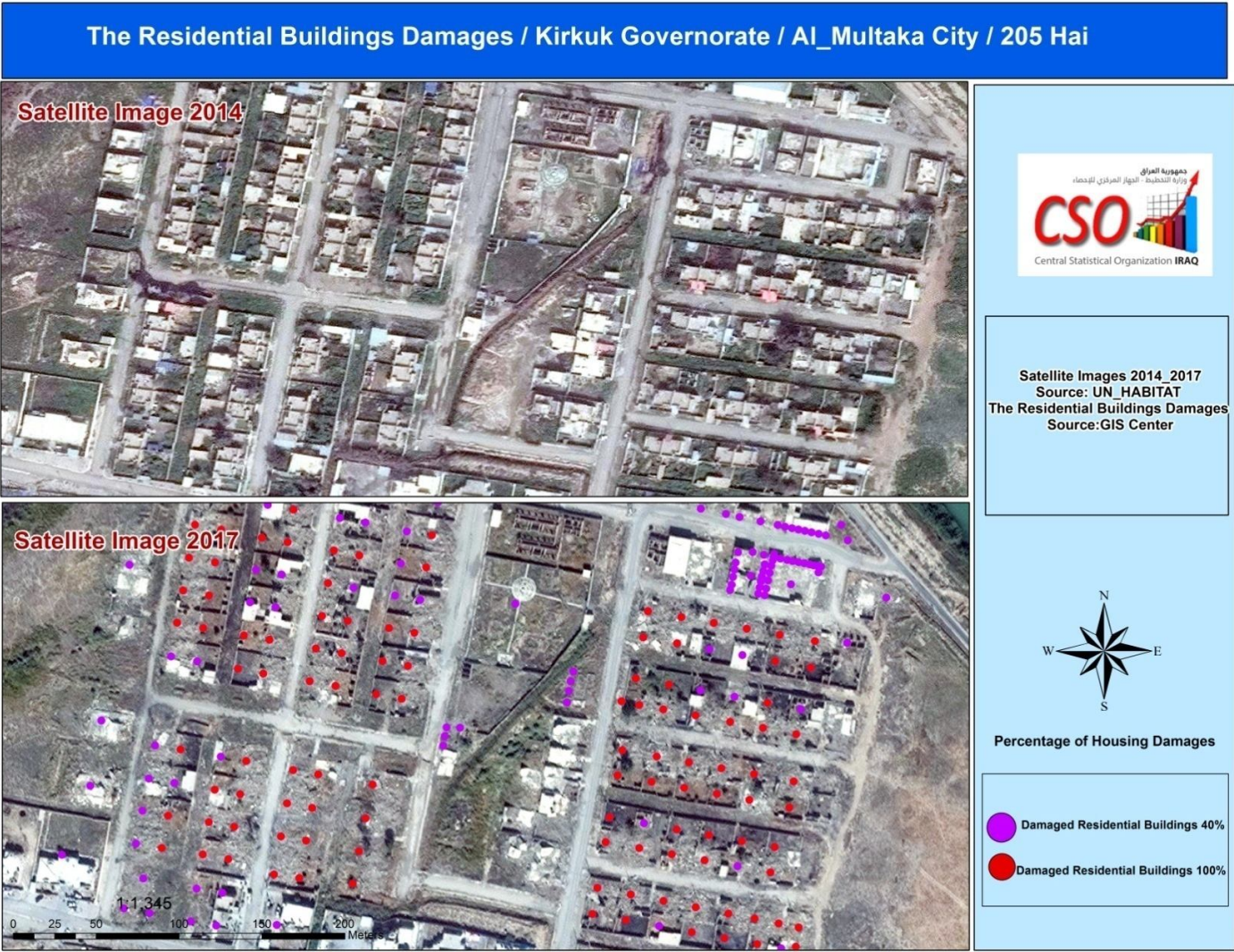
Map (13) : Comparison for the residential region in Al- Saqlawiya city for the years 2014 and 2017

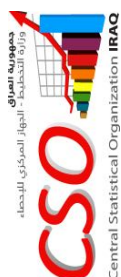
